Participantsas a team will also have chance to examine the mathematics curriculum in geometry for primary school, brash up their skill to anticipate students' response and discuss how to design Neriage phase.

A

Asynchronous activities that each participant complete individual assignments following the course schedule.

B

Local team meetings to complete team assignments following the course schedule. Each team should schedule the local meetings, either face-to-face or online using their resources.

C

One representative from each team will join the whole group online discussions with the seminar leaders to discuss critical issues in improving Lesson Study. All the team participants will be watching online discussions.


[Individual package] 60,000 JPY per one participant
